NMMC Facts

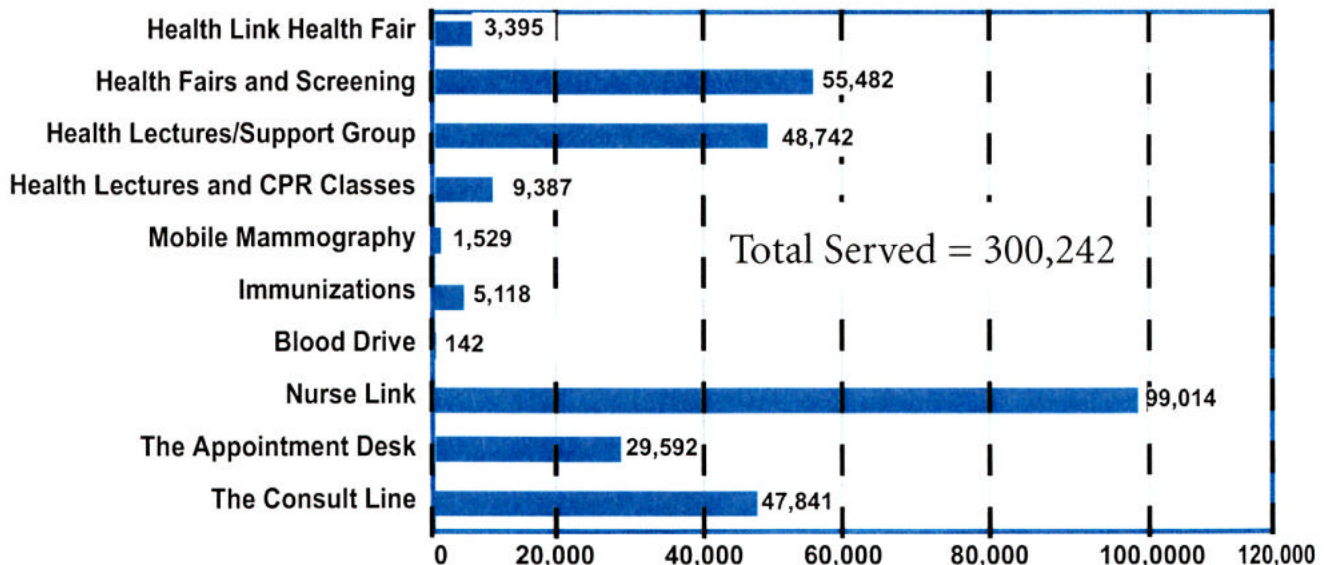
